

STUDENT VISA

JANUARY 2021

If you are a resident of Singapore and wish to study at a university in Germany you are required to obtain a residence permit in form of a national visa. This visa must be issued before you enter the country and can be applied for at the German Visa Application Centre:

VFS Global Visa Application Centre (79 Anson Road #15-02, Singapore 079906).

An appointment is required for submission of the application:

Processing of the visa takes **about 5 to 6 weeks** upon submission of complete documents. The residence permit can be issued only upon approval by the competent authorities in Germany. You will receive a prompt notification upon completion of the processing. We ask that no status request is made if the required 5 weeks processing period has not yet passed.

It is recommended that at no time a flight ticket should be purchased until a visa has been granted.

Please make sure to submit all the documents on the list in original **with 2 copies** when you show up for your appointment. Copies will not be made by the Embassy.

Please note that the application has to be submitted **personally**.

Fees: The visa fee of the Embassy is equivalent of EUR 75.00 in SGD. Additionally, VFS charges a service fee of EUR 34.13 in SGD

9.	proof of health insurance (travel health insurance) valid at least for the first 3 months of the stay	
10.	proof of German language knowledge – B2 level (if lectures being held in German language; if lectures will be held in English: a confirmation of the university)	
11.	<p>proof of finance of your stay in Germany with a minimum of Euro 861 per month, at least for 1 year (10.332 EURO) by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) a blocked account at a German bank showing a minimum amount according to the duration of your intended stay (withdrawal limit of € 861 per month). You have free choice of provider. Information on providers that offer this service worldwide is available on the Federal Foreign Office website: Information blocked account. OR b) proof of sponsorship/stipendium by a German institution OR c) a formal letter of obligation, according to paragraph §§66,68 of the Aliens Act, from a resident of Germany and for the duration of the applicant's stay in Germany
